



SILVER TOTEM Red Blend Washington

Area of Production:

Columbia Valley, Washington.

Soil:

Windblown loess intermixed with glacial silt on fractured basalt.

Grape Varieties:

Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Malbec.

Production Technique:

The grapes for our Silver Totem Red Blend take advantage of the best the Columbia Valley has to offer. The wines are pressed and aged in a mix of stainless-steel tanks and barrels for three months developing depth while maintaining purity of fruit. Each cuvée is evaluated, then returned to tanks and barrels, with a dash of toasted oak for nuance. This additional aging brings the wine together with one harmonious voice.

Characteristics:

Color: Deep ruby red.

Bouquet: Wild berries, tobacco leaf and toasted oak.

Taste: Round tannins provide the structure and support for the core of sweet fruit and vanilla finish.

Alcohol Content: 13.5%.
