LITORALE (LEE-TOE-RAL-LEH) VERMENTINO MAREMMA TOSCANA IGT

Production Area: Val delle Rose Estate located near Scansano, a small hamlet in Southern Tuscany's Maremma zone (Italy).

Grape Varieties: 85% Vermentino, 15% other complementary white grape varieties.

Description: Straw yellow, with gold reflections. Intense fruit-forward bouquet that suggests ripe exotic fruits. Fresh, crisp white with well-balanced acidity and an assertive finish.

Vermentino is the premier white grape grown along the Italian coastline caressed by the Tyrrhenian Sea, which separates the mainland regions of Tuscany and Liguria from the island of Sardinia. The warm climate in this southwestern part of Tuscany, known as the Maremma, produces varietal wines with the unmistakable characteristics of ripe fruit, yet the Vermentino grape retains a crisp backbone of refreshing acidity.

This wine is fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks followed by a minimum of two months of bottle refinement.

Litorale takes its name from the litoral winds that blow up and down the coastline. It marries well with salads, light fare, fish, fowl and cheese. Serve chilled.
