



THE CHÂTEAU 100 YEAR OLD VINES SHIRAZ

Production Area: Barossa, Australia.

Grape Variety: 100% Shiraz.

Description: The Château 100 Year Old Vines Shiraz is intense violet in color. Delicious aromas of dense, spicy blueberry intertwine with hints of licorice, plum and allspice. These notes reappear on the palate with leather and savory notes. Silky, with fine tannins and outstanding length and balance.

The grapes are handpicked from a one acre vineyard of vines over 100 years old located in the Eden Valley. Gentle basket pressing occurs in one single press, ensuring a silky, smooth texture in the wine and producing fine tannins. Aging takes place for 18 months in combination of new (30%) and old (70%) french puncheons. This wine will age gracefully for up to 15 years.

Château Tanunda, Australia's oldest and grandest chateau is the site of the very first vines planted in the Barossa in 1845. The majestic building is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a century old tradition of fine winemaking.

The Château 100 Year Old Vines Shiraz marries excellently with robust meats, and hearty pasta dishes.
