Cabernet Sauvignon 2011  
Emiliana

***Area of Production:***

Maipo Valley, Chile.

***Soil:***

Deep soils on alluvial terraces, excellent drainage.

***Grape Varieties:***

100% organically grown grapes.  
85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot.

***Production Technique:***

Hand picked the last 10 days of April and sorted for ultimate selection, 4-5 day cold soak and stainless steel fermentation. Malolactic fermentation occurs naturally in tanks and barrels and aged for 12 months – 35% in French oak, 35% American oak and 30% in stainless steel. Lightly filtered, not fined nor stabilized.

***Characteristics:***

*Color:* Intensely red.

*Bouquet:* Highly complex nose with aromas of cherries, black currants, black pepper and a touch of smoke.

*Taste:* A bold wine with elegant tannins, dark fruit flavors and a hint of spice. Good structure and a persistent finish.

*Alcohol Content:* 14%.

*Total Acidity:* 5.07 g/l.

Delicious with stews and grilled meats. Also pairs beautifully with rich pastas and cheeses.
