Medium ruby red with a bouquet of strawberry, rose hip and cranberry. Rainstorm Pinot Noir is soft and elegant with flavors of bright cherry, pomegranate and red berries.



RAINSTORM PINOT NOIR

Planted in 1992, the Rainstorm Estate Vineyard and Winery are located in the heart of the Valley, the newly recognized and often breezy, Van Duzer Corridor AVA. Committed to crafting award-winning Pinots at the site for more than two decades.

SOIL

Volcanic and sedimentary deposits in the Willamette Valley.

PRODUCTION TECHNIQUE

We harvest our Pinot Noir at about 23.5 Brix, gently de-stem before maceration. Our fermentations take about a week to avoid harsh tannic flavors. After pressing and malolactic fermentation, the wine ages 10-16 months in barrels and tanks before blending and bottling.

BOUQUET

Strawberry, rose hips and cranberry.

TASTE

Red berries, soft and elegant with flavors of bright cherry and pomegranate.

FOOD PAIRING

Ideal with grilled salmon, duck, mushroom risotto and pork loin.
