



SILVER TØTEM
Cabernet Sauvignon
Washington

Area of Production:

Wallula Vineyard, Horse Heaven Hills, Washington.

Soil:

Wind-blown loess on basalt bedrock.

Grape Varieties:

Primarily Cabernet Sauvignon with Malbec.

Production Technique:

Washington State's volcanic soils and drastic diurnal shifts are ideal for growing complex Cabernet Sauvignon. The grapes are picked late October at 24-26 brix and the total time on skins does not exceed 10 days. Half the wine is aged in oak barrels (30% new American oak) and the other half is aged in stainless steel tanks for 20-24 months.

Characteristics:

Color: Deep ruby red.

Bouquet: Cherry, cedar and violet.

Taste: Currant and blackberry.

Alcohol Content: 13.5%.
