



CHÂTEAU TANUNDA  
GRAND BAROSSA  
Cabernet Sauvignon 2010

**Area of Production:**

Barossa, Australia.

**Soil:**

Brown, loamy sand to clay loam and sandy light brownish grey to dark grey brown soils.

**Grape Varieties:**

90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Shiraz, 5% Cabernet Franc.

**Production Technique:**

The grapes are placed uncrushed into steel fermenters and spend 8 days on their skins before fermentation. Ageing takes place in medium toasted French oak for 18 months.

**Characteristics:**

**Color:** Deep brick red.

**Bouquet:** Lifted cassis, currant, herbals and choc mint with dark berry fruit.

**Taste:** Flavors of plum, cherry and mint with smooth tannins and a long velvety finish. Firm and full bodied. Ripe, rich and gently oaked. Very varietal.

**Alcohol Content:** 13.5%.

**Total Acidity:** 6.8 g/l.

Pair with roasted red meats, flavorful and hearty tomato based pastas, and strong-flavored cheese.
