



## GRAND BAROSSA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

*Production Area:* Barossa, Australia.

*Grape Varieties:* 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Shiraz,  
5% Cabernet Franc.

*Description:* GRAND BAROSSA Cabernet Sauvignon is brilliant ruby red in color with lifted aromas of blackcurrant, violet perfume and vanilla. Luscious bramble fruit, floral and sweet spice notes reappear on the palate. Medium to full bodied with great depth and balance, the wine is matured for 18 months in French oak. This generous and elegant Cabernet Sauvignon has a delightful lingering finish.

Château Tanunda, established in 1890 in the heart of the Barossa Valley, is Australia's oldest and grandest château. As the cornerstone of the Barossan wine industry, this first-growth château is the site of the first vines planted in the Barossa Valley in 1845 and is today, privately owned by the Geber family.

A brilliant accompaniment to roasted red meats, flavorful and hearty tomato based pastas, and strong-flavored cheese.
