GRAND BAROSSA
Dry Riesling 2012

Area of Production:

Barossa, Australia. 100% Estate owned.

Soil:

Shallow, pale loam over clay.

Grape Variety:

100% Riesling.

Production Technique:

Handpicked early in the morning. Gentle pressing, minimizes phenolics and cold settling precedes fermentation, capturing the delicacy, elegance and finesse of this noble variety. The wine is bottled immediately to retain freshness and vivacity. 40% of this wine comes from old vines planted in the 1920s.

Characteristics:

Color: Very pale straw.

Bouquet: Lifted aromas of lime blossom and citrus fruits.

Taste: Lemon, lime and hints of passion fruit flavors. The palate is focused, pure and linear with a delicious, juicy fruit finish. Elegant and intense with a touch of minerality.

Alcohol Content: 11.5%.

Total Acidity: 7 g/l.

An excellent match with seafood and light pasta dishes.
