



CHATEAU TANUNDA
GRAND BAROSSA
Shiraz 2010

Area of Production:

Barossa, Australia.

Soil:

Shallow, pale loam over clay, dark loams with ironstone.

Grape Varieties:

97% Shiraz, 3% Cabernet Franc.

Production Technique:

The grapes are placed uncrushed into steel fermenters. After fermentation, the skins are gently basket pressed, combining traditional methods with new technology. 100% matured in French (20%) and American (80%) oak for 18 months.

Characteristics:

Color: Deep red.

Bouquet: Dense lifted aromas of red berry fruit.

Taste: Soft and supple, yet elegant with plenty of upfront fruit. Hints of spice, pepper and vanillan oak. Beautifully balanced tannins derived from 18 months in American & French oak.

Alcohol Content: 14.5%.

Total Acidity: 7.4 g/l.

Delicious with rare, roast meats and tomato-based pasta dishes.
