



**RAINSTORM**  
Pinot Noir

***Area of Production:***

Willamette Valley, Oregon.

***Soil:***

Volcanic and sedimentary deposits in the Willamette Valley.

***Grape Variety:***

100% Pinot Noir.

***Production Technique:***

We harvest our Pinot Noir at about 23.5 Brix, gently de-stem before maceration. Our fermentations take about a week to avoid harsh tannic flavors. After pressing and malolactic fermentation, the wine ages 10-16 months in barrels and tanks before blending and bottling.

***Characteristics:***

*Color:* Medium ruby red.

*Bouquet:* Strawberry, rose hips and cranberry.

*Taste:* Red berries, soft and elegant with flavors of bright cherry and pomegranate.

*Alcohol Content:* 13%.

*Total Acidity:* 5.7%.

Ideal with grilled salmon, duck, mushroom risotto and pork loin.
