Sweet White Wine
Washington

Area of Production:

Columbia Valley Washington and California.

Grape Varieties:

Blend of Riesling, Pinot Gris (Washington),
Moscato (California).

Production Technique:

All the grapes are picked early and the juice is fermented in stainless steel tanks. The fermentation is arrested at 8.5% alcohol and 8.5% residual sugar. A fair amount of residual carbonation from fermentation is left in the wine.

Characteristics:

Color: Pale gold.

Bouquet: Citrus fruit and honeysuckle.

Taste: Green apple and honey.

Alcohol Content: 8.5%.

Total Acidity: 0.70%.

Residual Sugar: 8.5%.
